DEED OF TRUST
HELP IN SUFFERING

DECLARATION of Trust made thisday of March, one thousand nine hundred and eighty and executed by Miss Crystal Rogers (D/o. Colonel George William Rogers(deceased) HIS Sanctuary, Rajmata's Estate, Durgapura, Jaipur 302004 (hereafter called the author of the Trust).

WHEREAS the author of the Trust has had a life-long concern for animals and all living things, it was always her deepest desire to help and alleviate their pain and want. Out of this desire she founded in 1959 "The Animals' Friend" in Delhi and worked as Hony. Secretary of this organisation for 19 years. In 1978, having resigned from "The Animals' Friend" she decided to establish a Charitable Trust in Rajasthan in the name of "Help In Suffering"(HIS Fund).

THEREFORE the author of the Trust desires to create this Charitable Trust and to execute the requisite Deed of Trust. The author of the Trust will be the Managing Trustee of this Trust and hold it in the name of "Help In Suffering" which will be for ever an open Trust and it will be subject to the terms, powers, provisions and declaration hereafter mentioned.

3. Objects of the Trust:

- i) Animal Aid:
To help sick, suffering, ill-treated or starving animals wherever found. To house, treat and find

..homes for the homeless, as well as to give medical aid to sick or injured animals brought in for treatment by their owners.

ii) Ameliorative measures:

To establish or encourage the establishment of animal shelters, water troughs, pinjarapoles and the like for providing shelter and other amenities to animals incapacitated for work by reasons of old age, sickness or injury.

iii) Stopping Cruelty:

To reprove acts of cruelty wherever seen, and if necessary, reporting to the Police any act of cruelty seen on the roads or elsewhere, and to co-ordinate with the S.P.C.A., the Animal Welfare Board, the State Department concerned, and any other animal welfare organisation for promoting this objective.

iv) Humane Education:

To impart education in relation to the humane treatment of animals, encouraging the formation of public opinion against the infliction of pain or suffering to all living things whether by way of trade, sport, or animal experimentation. In particular to promote animal welfare and to awaken compassion for all living things by means of lectures, books, posters, film shows, exhibitions etc., especially directed towards the young.

v) Aid in human suffering:

Although primarily an animal-welfare organisation, the sufferings of human-beings crossing our path, who may be in much the same plight as a stray animal shall not be overlooked. To admit them into the

Sanctuary and give them whatever immediate treatment is needed, before passing them on to the proper institutions dealing with such cases, unless they can be suitably absorbed into the work of the Sanctuary.

vi) Collections:

To raise funds by lectures, the showing of films, fund-raising drives, and other such means, and by collecting used clothing, blankets and any form of material, not only for the use of animals, but for destitute human-beings also.

vii) News Letter:

To bring out a quarterly News Letter to acquaint members and sympathisers with the work being done.

viii) To employ such other charitable purposes not falling immediately under any of the above headings but being within the spirit and intention of valid Charitable Trusts as the Trustees may in their joint discretion decide.

That the activities of the Trust shall be in the State of Rajasthan or any other place or places which may be determined from time to time

xi) The Trustees shall maintain the affairs of the Trust with full powers and according to their convenience.

- xii) The Managing Trustee shall have powers to nominate one or more Trustees in case any vacancies occur.
- xiii) The Bank account shall be opened by the Managing Trustee who shall have the power to appoint another person to operate the Bank Account, if necessary.
- xiv) The Managing Trustee or a person appointed by her shall maintain the accounts for the Trust Fund wherein all the transactions relating to the Trust shall be mentioned. The Managing Trustee shall keep the accounts every year and shall prepare the final accounts of the Trust to be approved by all the Trustees of the Trust.
- xv) That the office of the Trust shall be honorary and the Trustees shall not draw any remuneration, but if any expenditure is incurred by any Trustee for the fulfilment of the objects of the Trust it shall be reimbursed.
- xvi) That the accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a chartered accountant appointed by the Trustees for that purpose.
